This is a paid opportunity for the summer of 2019, with flexible weekly hours, and some weekend hours may be required. **The student must be able to work a minimum of 8 - 10 hours per week (but could potentially work up to 24 hours per week) at our corporate headquarters located in downtown Buffalo.**

- An understanding of BlueCross BlueShield Association branding guidelines and internal style guides.
- Participation in a wide range of creative/design initiatives for internal and external clients.
- Opportunity to develop and utilize design, photography and/or video skills in a corporate environment.
- How to effectively communicate and interact with all levels of management.

Job Duties may include the following:

- Create or edit design layouts for both print and social media.
- Assist team members on photo and video shoots and post-production.

Required Skills and experience:

- Say Yes Scholars in their junior or senior year in the spring of 2019 enrolled in a 4-year program in Graphic Design with a minor in photography and/or video.
- Excellent written and verbal communications skills.
- Strong computer skills with knowledge of the Macintosh operating system, Adobe Creative Cloud applications (especially InDesign, Illustrator, Photoshop, Premiere). Working knowledge of PC and Microsoft Word and PowerPoint.
- Ability to work independently in fast-paced environment and handle multiple responsibilities and changing priorities within a tight timeframe.
