The Program

Discover Law provides 20 promising and diverse students the opportunity to live on the University at Buffalo's North Campus for an intensive four-week summer residency. Students take rigorous courses taught by law professors, attend field trips to see the law in action learn about the admissions process, and shadow a judge or attorney for a day. Throughout the four weeks, students build and refine skillsets such as:

- Critical thinking, close reading and legal analysis
- Enhanced writing and oral advocacy skills
- Practical strategies for doing well on the LSAT
- Successfully navigating the law school admissions process
